## What This Means for You (Customer)

We accept Bitcoin as payment for goods and services. Bitcoin is a digital payment network that lets you pay directly from your phone or computer — no bank needed, no card required.

1. Open your Bitcoin wallet app (e.g. Cash App, Revolut, BlueWallet)
2. Select "Pay with Bitcoin" or "Scan"
3. Scan the QR code shown by our staff member
4. Confirm the amount — it will be shown in pounds sterling
5. The payment is sent and confirmed — typically in seconds

### Is it safe?

Yes. Bitcoin payments are irreversible once confirmed. We will confirm your payment before completing your order. There are no chargeback fraud risks for you either.

### Do I need the internet?

Yes — a data connection is required to broadcast the payment. Most phones handle this on Wi-Fi or mobile data.

### What if I send the wrong amount?

Please speak to a staff member immediately. We'll resolve it on a case-by-case basis.

### Can I get a refund?

Our refund policy is explained before payment. Bitcoin refunds are handled in the same way — ask a staff member.

#### For Staff — When a Customer Wants to Pay with Bitcoin

1. Confirm the amount in sterling.
2. Open your payment app or bring up the customer's invoice QR code.
3. Show the QR code and confirm they have scanned it.
4. Wait for the payment notification.
5. Confirm the transaction is received before completing the sale.
6. Record the TX ID in your transaction log.

#### ⚠ If a customer doesn't have a Bitcoin wallet:

Suggest they set one up quickly using Cash App or Revolut. This takes a few minutes and they can be ready to pay within the session.

#### If a payment seems delayed:

Check your wallet for the transaction status. On-chain: check the TX ID on mempool.space. If unconfirmed after 2 hours: escalate to your manager.
